SKYPE is a wonderful tool for us to use in the ministry. It allows us to stay connected with the LATCOM workers in Bolivia. It was exciting to talk with the president of the REDES-Lomerio program, Juan Garcia, and his wife, Rosa, who have recently spent three months in Bible training. During these three months in Riberalta, Bolivia they learned more about the biblical perspective of a husband/wife relationship as well as other information about the fundamental precepts of ministry.

They were thrilled with what they learned and thankful for those who donated money so they could attend this intensive training.



Juan gave an update on the Coloradillo church construction and asked John to speak at the church in July when we will be in Bolivia. Our time then will focus on training and strategic planning with the Lomerio leaders. It is a blessing to see these REDES leaders taking greater ownership in the leadership and expansion of the ministry in their own towns and nearby communities.

The REDES leaders in the Lomerio have freed up Onesimo and Elodia Rojas (LATCOM national missionaries) to work in the areas around Concepcion in evangelism and training. There are over 50 communities in the Concepcion area which have no evangelical ministry and the Rojases will be concentrating on these unreached towns. In April we spent a week in Florida with Onesimo and Elodia Rojas and Nathan and Kathy Ramsey discussing some of the changes which need to occur in the ministry especially in relation to regulations by the Bolivian government and doing some strategic planning. We also began to plan and prepare for the July missions trip.

On the home front, we continue to minister in churches as well as work on projects for the LATCOM home office. John is preparing reports for the board meeting scheduled in May.

We are looking forward to the mission trip this summer. We plan to leave on June 29th and be in Bolivia for three weeks. We will be discussing with Bolivian leaders how best to evangelize their neighbors and will teach in the towns of Concepcion, Santa Cruz, and the Lomerio. Pray that the seminars offered will be effective in meeting the spiritual needs of the people.

We are thankful that our personal monthly support has remained steady and that LATCOM's overall financial picture has shown improvement in the past months. We continue to work on increasing our monthly support (see prayer section). It is also crucial for us to raise the money needed for Karen's plane ticket to Bolivia. Please pray this need will be met.
