SAN SIMON

A few years ago Pablo Chuve and believers from Monterito and Surusubí began evangelizing the community of San Simon. They held Bible School programs with the children and projected the Jesus film for the adults. Now the church of El Púquio has taken up the call to continue the work by helping Anacleto and his wife, who live in San Simon, to evangelize their own community using a special tool known as a Proclaimer.



TRAINING AND GIVING OF GIFTS

From December 7 to the 9 we held a leadership training conference for those leading the NETS Project in Porvenir near Concepcion. We evaluated the progress in the Project and we studied the need for unity among the believers. It was a time of rejoicing as we celebrated all that God has done in so many different ways. Thanks to a generous family each of the 15 leaders received a Christmas basket for which we were very grateful. An agronomist named Willy took advantage of the meetings to begin the initial training over how to begin co-operative farming with each church selecting where and how they would begin.



VISITA A LOMERIO

In November a mission team of volunteers along with Pablo Chuve went to visit 10 unreached Chiquitano communities in the Lomerio area with the goal of evaluating where they could begin community development projects as a first step toward evangelizing this vast unreached area.

GOOD NEWS CLUBS

Around 432 children attended Good News Clubs that were held in the month of September. These events, timed to correspond with the month of the Bible, were held in 6 communities under the leadership of Pablo Chuve and with local believers doing all of the teaching .

REFLECTION TIME

A GREAT SMALL MIRACLE

On many occasions God uses small events in our lives to teach us great lessons. One such example can be found in Luke 5:4-7. Jesus, on this occasion, used a small group of people who were willing to trust him and obey his commands to accomplish something great. There are three important lessons we can learn here.

1) If we listen to His word, He will teach us His will. The men in this story had been fishing all night and were returning home empty handed and tired. They were discouraged and yet they were willing to listen and obey Jesus command. They were willing to forgo their own needs and desires to fulfill His wishes.

2) If we do what he commands, He will show us His power. The phrase “when they had done so,” shows us they they didn’t argue or reason with Jesus but that they obeyed His request. Only when they obeyed His command did they see the miraculous power of Jesus. Likewise our obedience releases the power of God in our lives.

3) If we humble ourselves, He will raise us up to serve Him. Only those who willingly humble themselves, renounce their own selfish needs, and are willing to obey Jesus Christ can be fully used by Him. In so doing they will witness great miracles and see the hand of God in their lives.

CONCLUSION: Just like this small group of fishermen, we are able to clearly hear the commands of Christ in His Word when he tells us to “Go and make disciples.” If we obey this command we will then be witnesses to His great power as He transforms the lives of others through our work. You will be witnesses to a great miracle.
